



## Application for mother tongue tuition at primary school

The Swedish school law 7§ states that a student who has a guardian with another mother tongue than Swedish should be offered mother tongue tuition in that language provided that:

1. It is the student's daily language at home and
2. The student has basic knowledge in that language

There must be enough students requesting the language to form a group and for the Mother Tongue Centre to hire a teacher.

Mother tongue is taught before and after regular school hours.
